Dear Parent and AP Student:

Listed below is the AP exam schedule for the 2020-2021 school year. Students must register in their AP Class online at the College Board website. Once they register for the class and exam online, they need to pay in the guidance office by October 31, 2020.

The fee for each exam is \$95 (checks payable to HHS). All money is due in the guidance office by October 31, 2020. Students who qualify for a fee reduction... the cost will be \$53 per exam. There are different ways to qualify for a fee reduction; for example: you are eligible if you qualify for free or reduced lunch, etc. Please see Ms. Green, if you need more financial assistance.

Orders placed between the after the October 31, 2020 deadline will incur a \$40 late order fee.

The AP exam schedule is set by the College Board and I cannot take any liberties with the times and dates. Review it carefully for accuracy. If you have any conflicts with the testing schedule, please contact me immediately to set up the alternative testing times.


There will be an additional \$40 charge if you cannot take the exam on the scheduled date and require an alternative late testing date. The Alternative testing dates and times are predetermined by the College Board and must be approved.

Students will not be dismissed until an exam has officially ended; do not ask to leave early if you finish before the end of the exam. If you play a sport or have a job, it is your responsibility to inform your coach or employer of your AP Exam obligation, and arrangements should be made accordingly.

You are required to abide by the policies of both the College Board and Hickory High School during the exam period. Any misconduct will be reported and could jeopardize your AP Exam grade.
