Job Shadowing Guidelines

1. Not a requirement by HHS
2. Parent/guardian permission required for all school coordinated job shadows.
3. All grades must be above 75% to attend a job shadow.
4. It is an excused absence from school.
5. It is the student's responsibility to turn in all due work ahead of the absence and retrieve all missed work from the day of the job shadow.
