Listed below is the AP exam schedule for the 2016-2017 school year. The AP exam schedule is set by the College Board and I cannot take any liberties with the times and dates. Review it carefully for accuracy. If you have any conflicts with the testing schedule, please contact me immediately to set up the alternative testing times.

If you are planning to take an AP exam you must register in the guidance office by February 28, 2017. The fee for each exam is \$93 (checks payable to HHS).

Fee Reduction: However, if you qualify for a fee reduction the cost will be \$53. If your son/daughter qualifies for a fee waiver, please have them register in the guidance office for the exam and tell Mrs. Foster, guidance secretary, that he/she will receive a reduction. There are different ways to qualify for a fee reduction; for example: you are eligible if you qualify for free or reduced lunch, etc. Please see Ms. Green if you think you may qualify for a fee reduction for any reason. The fee reduction could be lower once the state reduction is released, **therefore do not send payment until we are notified of the state reduction.**

There will be an additional \$45 charge if you cannot take the exam on the scheduled date and require an alternative late testing date. The Alternative testing dates and times are predetermined by the College Board and must be approved.

Students will not be dismissed until an exam has officially ended; do not ask to leave early if you finish before the end of the exam. If you play a sport or have a job, it is your responsibility to inform your coach or employer of your AP Exam obligation, and arrangements should be made accordingly.

You are required to abide by the policies of both the College Board and Hickory High School during the exam period. Any misconduct will be reported and could jeopardize your AP Exam grade.
