1. EPILEPSY FOUNDATION WESTERN/CENTRAL PENNSYLVANIA SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION

The purpose of this scholarship is to assist an individual who has epilepsy with his/her academic and/or vocational training. Applications are available in the guidance office.
Completed applications are due in the guidance office by March 10, 2017 to arrive by the scholarship deadline of March 17, 2017.

2. UNITED STATES JCI SENATE FOUNDATION

\$1,000 grants will be awarded to graduating high school seniors in the US who plan to continue their education at accredited post-secondary colleges, universities or vocational schools. Applications are available on line at www.usjcisenate.org or in the guidance office.
Completed applications must be postmarked by January 20, 2017.

3. UPMC HORIZON GREENVILLE AUXILIARY; EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE AWARD PROGRAM

This program is to encourage students to prepare for selected careers in hospital-based health care. This scholarship will award up to \$1,000. Applications are available on line at www.upmc.com or in the guidance office.
Completed applications must be postmarked by March 1, 2017.

4. PSECU SCHOLARSHIP

The purpose of this scholarship is to award up to six \$8,000 scholarships to graduating seniors who are members of a PSECU. Applications are available online at www.psecu.com/scholarships.
Completed applications are due in the guidance office by February 21, 2017 to arrive by the scholarship deadline of noon on February 28, 2017.

5. THE LOIS MACALUSO CHARITABLE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

This program is for students pursuing further education leading to a career in healthcare. Applications are available in the guidance office.
Completed applications are due in the guidance office by April 7, 2017 to arrive by the scholarship deadline of April 15, 2017.
