**Hermitage School District
Student Chromebook Acceptance Form**

Students in the Hermitage School District will be issued a Chromebook for their educational use. This Student Chromebook Acceptance Form (the "Agreement") ensures that equipment supplied by the Hermitage School District (the "District") will be used and maintained in its original condition, reasonable wear and tear excepted, by the student who signs it ("Student"). By signing this form, the student will demonstrate reasonable care with the respect to the security and physical well-being of the equipment assigned to his/her care. In the absence of reasonable care or if the equipment is returned in a condition different than the original condition, reasonable wear and tear excepted, the student will be financially responsible. In addition, in the event the Hermitage School District determines in its sole discretion that the borrower did not utilize reasonable care in the use of the equipment, the student will be responsible for any damaged, lost, or stolen equipment. The Chromebook and its accessories are the property of the District.

Please do not remove any Identification Tags from any component. If in the event that any of these tags become removed, please notify the school office IMMEDIATELY for a replacement.

By signing this agreement, the student acknowledges and agrees:

- To abide by the Hermitage School District Acceptable Use Policy.
- To use the Chromebook primarily for educational use.
- That the Chromebook is issued to the student who, with his/her parents or guardians, are the only authorized users of the Chromebook.
- That while the equipment is connected to the Internet, its use will be logged.
- To not attempt to circumvent the District's Internet content filter.
- The District will provide remote Internet content filtering, however the filter should not be used as a substitute for parental supervision.
- To not install or remove any software without prior authorization from the District.
- To report any problems or damages immediately to their teacher.
- That the device and its accessory equipment (case, battery, and power cord) are the property of the Hermitage School District unless purchased by the student.
- If the parent/guardian elects to pay the Annual Technology Fee, to return the equipment before the student's last day of school if the student is transferring out of the District.
- That if the equipment is not returned to the District in its original condition, reasonable wear and tear excepted, or if the equipment is damaged, lost, or stolen, due to student's negligence or not utilizing reasonable care in the use of the equipment, the student agrees to be financially responsible for the replacement value of the equipment as determined by the District.
- That all information stored on equipment carries no expectation of privacy and is property of the District.
- That it is the student's responsibility to charge the device each night and to bring it to school each day.

To the extent the student is a minor, a parent/guardian must sign this Agreement. The Parent/Guardian signing below agrees to be bound by this Agreement and financially responsible for the equipment.

By signing this form, the Student and the signing Parent/Guardian acknowledge and agree that any information or use of the equipment carries no expectation of privacy. The District reserves the right, at all times and without prior notice, to inspect and search any and all its property for the purpose of determining whether any policy has been violated, or when an inspection and investigation is necessary for purposes of promoting safety or compliance with state and federal laws.
