

HHS Silver Cord Program

Hours that **DO** count:

- All activities on HHS approved agency list
 - If an agency is not on our list, they must be approved before the start of hours
- Students must complete 150 hours at a minimum of 4 locations throughout their 4 years of high school.

Guidelines:

- To satisfy Silver Cord hours, students need 150 hours at a minimum of 4 locations by May 1st of their senior year.
- Students may satisfy their 150 hour requirement at any time throughout their four years at HHS beginning the summer prior to their freshman year
- All summer hours must be turned in by the last Friday of September
- Students must meet the deadline for submitting their documentation

All updated hours must be documented by the last Friday of each month. Hours turned in after the deadline will not be counted toward Silver Cord hours.

Hours that **DO NOT** count:

- Chores at home/farm
- Babysitting for an individual family
- Court ordered community service
- If you receive compensation
- Work that is done for family members
- Hours performed as a member of HHS sports team, club, or activity
